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• Break it down: Why, what and how Why your solution or idea is

necessary and how it will benefit people; what your idea is - a brief summary; how it works, and how you plan to execute it.

Keep it simple

Unless the argument requires a lengthy explanation, keep all your lines and pointers short, sweet and to the point. You can always go into detail when they buy into it. Add all the findings from your research and testing wherever it can reinforce an argument. Also, add a few pictures - it helps break the monotony of text.

• Let the data

do the talking

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• Make a short version Apart from a full-length presentation, create an elevator pitch as well, which shouldn't be longer than 30 seconds. This will help you effectively pitch your idea to someone important, who doesn't have a lot of time.
