Executive Summary:

The Company had spent ₹ 129 crore, ₹ 58.35 crore and ₹ 68.08 crore in the financial years 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 respectively, towards CSR activities. The Company had identified 15 CSR projects qualifying the requirements of Rule 8(3) of the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 for conducting Impact Assessment. Impact Assessment study carried out by an independent agency covered projects from areas such as Health, Education & Skill Development and Rural Upliftment.
